

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FAQ: Consumers

What does the QC3 do for me?

The QC3 offers a tool for finding, choosing, and hiring a Provider. This is the Registry, or list, of Providers. This list will have names of Providers and information such as the language they speak, what work they willing to do.

The QC3 also offers Consumers information about being an employer of an in-home Provider. The QC3 will also help with training for Consumers who want to learn more about being an employer.

One duty of the QC3 is to find new Providers for the Registry. This will give Consumers more choices for Providers.

What is the Registry?

The Registry is a list of Providers that have been screened by the QC3.

What Provider information will be on the Registry?

The Provider can choose to be on the Registry and also what information is on the Registry. The QC3 will screen the Provider to be sure certain information such as name, contact information, and where they would like to work is included. Other items may be what languages the Provider speaks and smoking preferences. All of these items will help you find the Provider that is right for you.

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
